



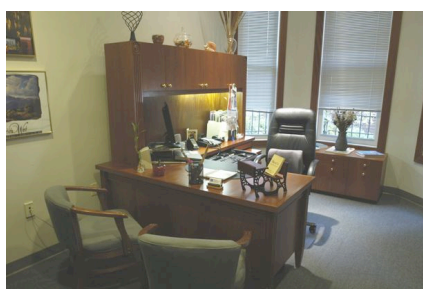

The Positive Influence of Feng Shui for Our Turbulent Times



Can feng shui impact the stock market, the mortgage crises or international conflict? Probably not in any way we could measure. Yet feng shui can make a difference to us by contributing to the clarity and character of our environment. When an office has a calm

atmosphere we are in a better position to make important decisions. Certainly an environment that limits stress and emulates harmony is a healthier place to work. I've experienced moving office furnishings literally inches and my client said, "I can't believe how much better it feels in here." When I position a client's desk in one of his or her 4 best directions (for prosperity, clarity, healing or harmony) a significant shift happens and their effectiveness is increased.

Whether I'm analyzing an entire building or one room, there is always an area that relates to 'wealth.' Diagonally across from the 'wealth' sector is the area referred to as 'benefactors'. In business, 'benefactors' relates to our clients, lenders, associates, networking partners, etc. These areas of 'wealth' and 'benefactors' work in tandem. Wealth is ignited by the element 'Wood' in feng shui. I look for both symbols of Wood (photos, colors and geometry) as well as actual Wood to enhance this area. Wood in turn fuels the element 'Fire'. Fire correlates to our reputation. Particularly during difficult times our reputation is one factor we must keep in tact and build on.

The nature of Fire is to spread. It is important to be conscious of our words and actions - what we are spreading. Is it fear, optimism, resignation, anger? This applies to how we see the world and in turn how the world sees us. Our inner perceptions subtly and not so subtly, determine the results we produce in our lives.

Our offices and homes need to provide us with a healthy place to think clearly, act appropriately, enhance our good fortunes and provide the best for others. A thriving environment provides a springboard which supports us to make a positive difference in our world.

Even in our newly 'netted' world, Alaska still evokes a far off unknown place. 'Wow' has generally been the reaction when I've mentioned my trip to our 49th State. My recent trip was the inspired idea of my parents, who wanted to celebrate their 60th Anniversary (another place many of us will not get to) on an Alaskan cruise with the family.



We were offered breathtaking natural beauty. The excitement of seeing whales, grizzly bears and bald eagles cannot be compared with much else. Our ship silently navigating toward the blue ice glacier called Hubbard was awesome. These beautiful moments offered me first hand experience of what is at stake as our planet becomes more and more out of balance.



Most of Alaska can only be reached by plane or boat (by 'wind or water' ~ the literal meaning of feng shui). Alaska is one-fifth the size of the lower 48 states, two and a half times larger than Texas, and larger than the next three largest states in the U.S. combined. Alaska has .93 square miles for each

person in the state; by comparison, New York has .003 square miles per person. As Americans Alaska's wildlife and wilderness are our responsibility.

There are so many wonderful organizations helping our planet at this time. The [National Resource Defense Council's](#) effort to limit oil drilling in the Alaska's Arctic Wildlife Refuge is one I presently support.

I also recommend that if you do not already offset your carbon footprint, that you check out the [Carbon Fund](#) a non-profit organization that is helping us help our planet, by responsibly compensating for what we use. Learning about this way of cleaning up after myself, has allowed me to regenerate the planet from the carbon emissions I used on my flights and cruise, to and from Alaska - very cool!
