Spring season, is often associated with ideas of rebirth and renewal. At the axis of the Earth is increasing its tilt toward the Sun, the warming northern hemisphere significantly causes new plant growth to "spring forth." giving the season its name.

On the Feng Shui template or bagua, the number '3' is associated with early spring and the eastern direction.
